Monkey Bars!

Pupil voice is something we really value and over the years we have made many changes here in school as a result of listening to the ideas, thoughts and opinions of the children. More recently a Year 3 pupil approached me about the rules around using the monkey bars in the playground. There is currently a height restriction in place which sometimes results in pupils still being forbidden to use them even in Year 6. It's not the first time this has been raised by the children as being unfair, many arguing that when they go to the park they can use play equipment which is much more challenging than the monkey bars! However, Frances raised the question again which led us to reconsider the rule and reinvestigate the health and safety aspects of the rule.

As a result, we have made the decision that all children from Years 3-6 will be allowed to use the monkey bars but we will need signed permission from parents to allow this to happen. A letter will be coming home next week which will need to be signed and returned to school so that after half term the rules can be changed. If you wish to have a look at the monkey bars before making a decision about whether you are happy for your child to use them, they are just outside the F2 classroom.
