<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We adopt a creative topic based curriculum designed to meet the needs of all learners. • All children are provided with a curriculum designed to enhance and broaden their life experiences. • Children make good progress in all areas due to the broad curriculum they receive. • English and maths skills are enhanced by the learning opportunities provided across the curriculum. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The curriculum is reviewed annually by all teaching staff and adapted where needed to meet the needs of individual cohorts. • Follows the National curriculum which is mapped by objectives throughout the whole school • Whole school overview to ensure coverage and a broad and balanced curriculum • Termly/ half termly topic maps sent home to parents and displayed on classroom doors/ windows/ website. • Teachers are motivated by exciting topics which allow them flexibility in how they deliver the learning to the children. • A wide range of resources are used to support and enhance delivery of the curriculum, e.g. artefacts, digital media, visitors. • Trips/ visitors/ outdoor opportunities enhance the curriculum and provide children with new experiences and opportunities to meet and explore different cultures and faiths. • Displays support, enrich and celebrate the broad range of topics and learning experiences that children access. • The school website and Facebook page are being developed to share the children's learning with the wider community. • Strong links with the local church and wider community enable pupils to interact and share their learning with others e.g. Carols around the tree, food bank, • The outdoor environment is being developed to support the curriculum and is currently proving especially beneficial in a nurture role. E.g. school garden. • A wide range of clubs which are reviewed termly offer opportunities to develop skills and further children's interest/ increase access. • Library stock is currently being reviewed to support the topics in each year group and the interests of the children. • Festival of arts and school performances enable children to share their skills and learning experiences. • Attainment and progress is recorded using TT annually and reported to parents in the end of year report. • Topic writing is included in writing books to ensure consistent standards across all subject areas (not just English), this is monitored by the writing lead and during curriculum book looks. • Children are provided with opportunities to practise and develop English and maths skills in other subject areas. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children are motivated by their topics and talk about their learning positively. • Children are given a wide range of learning opportunities to enhance and develop their skills for life. • Children leave Pencoys having had the opportunity to succeed and celebrate their achievements across the curriculum. • During pupil conferencing pupils are keen to share their learning. • Pupils are keen to extend their own learning at home/ in the classroom.
